Fear Not

As believers, we have been given authority over the devil! We have this directly from Jesus Himself: "Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and (physical and mental strength and ability) over all the power that the enemy [possesses], and nothing shall in any way harm you" (Luke 10:19). Further reinforcement of this is found in Colossians 1:12-13: "...the Father...has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of his dear Son." There is no question whether you, as a believer, have authority over the devil. Through His death, burial and resurrection, Jesus destroyed the works of the devil (see Ephesians 4:8; Colossians 2:15). Jesus gave authority to those who believe in His Name to cast out the devil: "And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils..." (Mark 16:17). Notice He said, "In My name...." You have at your disposal Jesus' Name to combat the devil: "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth" (Philippians 2:10). The power of God stands behind the Name of Jesus to deliver you from the power of Satan. So, take courage in the fact that you have been given authority over the devil! God doesn't want you to have fear over anything because He promised to never leave or abandon you (Hebrews 13:5). In fact, the phrase "Fear not" appears in more than 60 verses of the Bible! So, what do we do if fear is tormenting us? The fastest way to remove fear from our lives is to focus on God's love for us. As we think on the love of God, we will see fear and worry go away. First John 4:18 says, "Love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear. If we are afraid, it is for fear of punishment, and this shows that we

have not fully experienced His perfect love." As challenging as the torment of fear and worry can be, it is no match for God's love. It has to take a back seat when your focus is on God as a loving Father who cares for you and wants you to prosper. Thoughts of fear that come into your mind can be knocked down simply by speaking God's Word out of your mouth. The Word of God is not just helpful for pulling down strongholds—it is mighty when it comes to pulling down Satan's strongholds (2 Corinthians 10:4-5). Here are some examples of how you can speak God's Word by faith: • "God is on my side!" (Psalm 118:6; Hebrews 13:6). • "Since God is for me, who can be against me?" (Romans 8:31). • "No weapon turned against me will succeed" (Isaiah 54:17). • "My God will supply all my needs!" (Philippians 4:19). • "The Holy Spirit is guiding me toward the truth" (John 16:13). • "Greater is He that is in me than he who is in the world!" (1 John 4:4). When you know that God loves you, and you allow that love to fill every area of your life, fear cannot stay. It has no other option. Anxiety, fear and worry must leave.

I wanted to share a little bit about our food pantry! God placed a desire and vision on my heart about helping those in need. I care so much about people and I feel for others and what they go through. God gave me a vision about opening a food pantry. To help people with food to eat, to encourage people to give them hope! To show them love and that someone cares about what they are going through. But besides all of those things, God wanted these people to be ministered to. To tell them how God loves and cares so much

about them. He wanted the people who came to the food pantry to first receive spiritual food and also food to eat.

How would I ever open a food pantry, how could I ever do this on my own and where would I ever open a food pantry and where would the food come from? I had a will and an open heart to do this. Every 1st Sunday of each month we set out a money jar for loose change or any amount that people want to give, we accept gift cards of any amount for grocery stores. We accept canned goods, boxed and bagged goods. We do ask that no outdated foods be brought into the pantry, also no dented cans, torn boxes and bags. When we give, we give as if we are giving to the Lord!!!

You can give to the food pantry at any time, not just the 1st of each month. You can also place money or gift cards into the offering boxes and label the envelope with "The Pantry of Hope". You can bring food in and place it under the coat rack by the entrance of the church. Also, if you don't come to our church and would like to contribute, you can send a check or gift cards to our church or give the church a call. We always appreciate everything people do for our food pantry. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for everything you do for "The Pantry of Hope"! Also pray for our ministry!
