Following is my testimony about standing strong and how God revealed to me that most people give up too quick on their prayers (which I used to do, also) because they are setting their own time limit on when it should manifest in the physical.

There are many verses in the Bible that tell us to stand fast, stand firm, be strong, but do we really do it (Daniel 10: 19, Ephesians 6: 13-14, I Thessalonians 3: 8, II Thessalonians 2: 15, I Peter 5: 12). Do we stand on what we believe or do we give up when circumstances don't look like our prayer is coming true? Do we put our own time limit on when the answer should come? There is no time limit with God. One day is as a thousand years. I love Daniel chapter 10. It describes a vision that Daniel had where he saw an angel who said, "Since the first day you began to pray for understanding and to humble yourself before your God, your request has been heard in Heaven. I have come in answer to your prayer. But for 21 days the spirit prince of the kingdom of Persia blocked my way. Then Michael, one of the archangels, came to help me..... Daniel became weak, his strength was gone and he could hardly breathe.

Then the angel touched him again and his strength returned. "Don't be afraid," he said, "for you are very precious to God. Peace! Be encouraged! Be strong!"

In this time, we must be strong! We can't afford to give up on our faith. If we do, we are giving up on God's Word. God's Word is truth! God said his Word would not return to Him void.
