Teach Me: Love Unconditional Part 1

The verdict came back. I was found guilty. Guilty of loving upon condition. In my vows both as a follower of Christ and as a wife, I had vowed to love unconditionally. My intentions were always just that, and I believed I was, in fact, honoring that promise. The only problem was, I failed to understand what I had promised to do.

In my feeble mind, to love unconditionally meant to love no matter what. In sickness and in health. The good days and the bad days. The ups and the down. No matter what, I would still say "I love you".

Did you know, to love is an action? A verb. The love we will be talking about in this 3part series is an action word. Not a feeling, not a phrase. Love requires a decision and dedication to execute to the full extent of the command, love unconditionally.

So, if I agreed to love no matter what, where did I go wrong? I was caught red handed in the act of using my love as a form of manipulation. I withheld my love when I didn't get my own way, or when someone didn't agree with me. Especially, when I felt offended, I used my love as leverage. Not just once, but for as far back as I dare to reflect!

Maybe the silent treatment. Maybe I withheld my affection. How about the times I replaced the gentleness in my voice with rude and harsh tones? Or how about the times I felt I "deserved" better treatment so I went on strike and purposely neglected my responsibilities, the very ways I show my love best. Oh, how many times my love proved to be conditional.

The day I came to this realization, that I had actually never truly loved anyone unconditionally, I fell to my knees.

Our Heavenly Father met me there. He wrapped me in His grace. He showed me where I was missing it and taught me the true definition of unconditional love. He taught me to love like Jesus.

Once I understood, I recommitted to love unconditionally. We have been called to love like Jesus. To love unconditionally means that you must love with the same intensity, constantly.

If you were tried and your love put to the test, would you be found guilty of loving upon condition? Are there ways you have used your love as leverage? Not just in your marriage, but in every personal relationship. At home or at work. Friends and family, church family. Our assignment as believers is to love everybody unconditionally.

Take some time now to reflect on your love walk. I encourage you to examine yourself. Have you missed the mark? Maybe you, like me, never truly understood what it meant to love unconditionally. Talk to your Heavenly Father. Lay it at His feet. Allow Him to cover you in Grace and to teach you to love like Jesus. For He himself, IS love.

His mercies are new every day. Every day is a new opportunity to give it your best and try again. As with any verb, any action, practice produces steady improvement. Be encouraged, greater is He who is in you. And you can do all things through Christ who is your strength.

Love does not demand its own way... Love keeps no record of being wronged. 1 Corinthians 13:5

Let's read 1 John 4:7-21 to gain understanding of the love the Lord expects of His children;

Loving One Another

"Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love—not

that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other. No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and His love is brought to full expression in us. And God has given us His Spirit as proof that we live in Him and He in us. Furthermore, we have seen with our own eyes and now testify that the Father sent His Son to be the Savior of the world. All who declare that Jesus is the Son of God have God living in them, and they live in God. We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in His love. God is love, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them. And as we live in God, our love grows more perfect. So we will not be afraid on the day of judgment, but we can face Him with confidence because we live like Jesus here in this world. Such love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear. If we are afraid, it is for fear of punishment, and this shows that we have not fully experienced His perfect love. We love each other because He loved us first. If someone says, "I love God," but hates a fellow believer, that person is a liar; for if we don't love people we can see, how can we love God, whom we cannot see? And He has given us this command: Those who love God must also love their fellow believers.

COMING IN I WANTED TO CONTINUE WHAT SISTER DARLENE HAD STARTED AND CONTINUE TO BUILD THE VISION THE LORD PLACED ON OUR WONDERFUL PASTOR, PASTOR JOHN'S HEART. IT HAS BEEN MY PLEASURE AND A BLESSING TO BE A PART OF THE TEAM. CHILDREN CAN DO MIGHTY THINGS THROUGH CHRIST, JUST LOOK AT DAVID! THE MORE RELATIONSHIPS OUR CHILDREN BUILD THE MORE LIKELY THEY ARE TO STAY. WE HAVE AN AMAZING TEAM THAT TRAINS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR TO CONTINUE TO BETTER OUR CARE.
