Unraveling the Mystery of Joy Unspeakable Part 1

I have titled this 2-part series "Unraveling the Mystery of Joy Unspeakable". When we start to unravel a mystery, first we must start by asking some questions. The very first question that we are going to ask is, "what is joy?" I have found some definitions to share so that we can begin break it down.

Dictionary Definition: Joy (noun) (something that we can have possession of) A feeling of great pleasure and happiness.

The biblical term "Joy" means; Blessed assurance that God is in control. A spiritual joy ride through life, if you will.

The word Joy translates to the Greek word – Chara. Chara describes a feeling of inner gladness, delight or rejoicing.

Chara describes it as a feeling of "inner gladness", the dictionary's definition of the word "joy" describes it as a possession, whereas the word that we are speaking of is something that is inside of us. It's not something that we can go out and grab, it's not tangible.

Now that we know the definition of "joy", what is joy unspeakable? Joy unspeakable is joy that is so great, so wonderful, magical, marvelous, and magnificent that we, in our human language, could never accurately depict it. We cannot articulate it because there are not enough words in the human language to be able to accurately describe joy unspeakable.

This joy is a deeply rooted sense of well-being and right standing with the Lord. So, why is it unspeakable? Because this joy is other worldly. It cannot be duplicated or replicated. There is no synthetic version of this joy. It is authentic joy that comes only from our Heavenly Father. It is a spiritual joy, intended for a spiritual being. As spiritual beings we are entitled to joy unspeakable.

Now that we know what "joy" and "joy unspeakable" are, the next question is, how do we obtain joy unspeakable? It's simple! Joy unspeakable is a gift! It's a Fruit of the Spirit. We gain access to it the day that we accept Jesus Christ into our hearts.

How do we maintain joy unspeakable? By living a life that is holy, acceptable, and pleasing to God. God wants us to have joy unspeakable. That is why its included in that pretty little gift basket that's wrapped up with a bow, delivered straight from the Lord's heart to ours the day that we accept His Son.

Take a look at 1 Peter 1:8-9 (NIV)

Though you have not seen Him, you love Him; and even though you do not see Him now, you believe in Him and are filled with inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

What Peter is saying is because we have the faith to believe in a God that we don't see, and we have the faith to love a Savior that we have never met or touched, we are to receive a gift. Joy unspeakable! Inexpressible joy because of our faithfulness.

The true gift is the Holy Spirit. He comes bearing gifts every single time we allow Him to come and be in the driver's seat. When we allow Him to move freely in our lives. How we do that is by creating a welcoming atmosphere for Him to move.

When we create an atmosphere for Him to move and He is in the driver's seat, He is going to take us great places. The ultimate goal as a born-again believer, as a follower of Christ, is to be like Christ. To imitate Christ and to do everything in reflection of Jesus Christ. When we allow the Holy Spirit to drive, that is where He is taking us. With every direction, every turn He takes us, the ultimate destination is in mind, to be like Christ.

The words that we speak greatly affect our ability to maintain joy unspeakable. Although joy unspeakable is a gift, it is our responsibility to maintain it and to live in joy unspeakable, every day. We do that with the words that we speak.

Proverbs 15:4 (AMP)

A soothing tongue (speaking words that build up and encourage) is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue (speaking words that overwhelm and depress) crushes the spirit.

Speaking words of life, love, peace, encouragement, positivity and especially speaking God's Word is how we are going to maintain joy unspeakable in our own lives. In Part 2 we are going to learn how we can share this joy unspeakable with others.

In the meantime, I want to encourage you to access your joy unspeakable. Tap in. Live in it, rest in it. Put into practice the principles that the Lord has put into place for our benefit. Remember, God's way is eternally rewarding, here on earth and in the heavens above.

I Am Not Ashamed of the Gospel of Christ

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. Romans 1:16

The Gospel, "the Good News", is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. If they don't believe the Gospel, they will remain lost in sin. This isn't just any natural power; it's the supernatural power of God that when believed it has the ability to bring a person from spiritual death to spiritual life. Jesus calls spiritual life being "born again" (John 3:3). The

apostle Paul says when a person believes the Gospel, they become a "new creation" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Spiritual death is when a person is separated from God through sin. This is what happened to Adam and Eve when they sinned in the Garden of Eden. The death that happened to them was two-fold. The spiritual death of no longer having the life of God in their spirit happened first. Then eventually physical death occurred due to the curse that came through sin. When a person accepts Jesus Christ by believing the Gospel, God sends the Holy Spirit to live within their Born-Again spirit. Yes, God downloads Himself within the Believer. Imagine that! Their bodies become the temple of the Holy Spirit (I Corinthians 6:19). If that doesn't light a fire within a person their wood must be wet. No wonder the Gospel says, "greater is He who is within me than he that's in the world" (1 John 4:4).

All scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. Il Timothy 3:16

The Gospel was written by 40 men over a period of 1500 years. All of these men were inspired by the Holy Spirit when they wrote the Gospel. The Holy Spirit is the author of the Bible.

The Gospel tells us of a God who loves us and has made a way for us to have eternal life through Jesus Christ (John 3:16). The Gospel tells us that we have all sinned and are in need of a Savior (Romans 3:23). The Gospel tells us about our Savior Jesus Christ who took our place on the cross and died for our sins so we can receive forgiveness (2 Corinthians 5:21). The Gospel tells us about our need for repentance (Matthew 3:2). The Gospel tells us that salvation is a gift by God's grace when we believe, and we can't earn salvation through our works (Ephesians 2:8).

Jesus said His followers are to go into all the world and preach the Gospel (Mark 16:15). Even in these difficult times all Believers must be brave and be remain faithful to this calling. Jesus said that persecution will come for the Words sake (Mark 4:17) and if the world hates you, know that they hated Him first (John 15:17). I have a saying, "I would rather be out on a limb with Jesus Christ than standing on 'solid' ground with the devil." In other words, take this whole world just give me Jesus.

There is a fierce battle going on right now for the souls of the lost. Keep getting the Gospel into as many as you can because it is the light that Satan is hiding from those who are lost in darkness.

You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let there be light in the darkness," has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ." 2 Corinthians 4:3-6 NLT
